Fire, Windstorm or hail, explosion, Riot or civil commotion, impact by aircraft, smoke, vandalism or malicious mischief, power surge, breakage of glass, theft, falling objects, weight of ice, snow, sleet, sudden water discharge from plumbing or appliances, sudden tearing/bulging of heating or cooling systems, freezing of plumbing system.

Insurance Coverage Options:

Dwelling
Separate Structure – garage, barn, shed, outside grills, pools,
Personal Property – jewelry, clothes, valuables, other personal items
Loss of Use
Liability – animals, hazards in house (injury on property)
