How it all Works: Any rider can start from any location at 7:00am but must be at the Newport Dunes between 11:30 and noon to qualify for the most miles award. If you don't care about the most miles award, arrive at any time after noon and start drinking beer. We will be using an application called Strava.com that will track your time and mileage. Remember the "Four Way Test"!

What does registration include? A registration fee of \$25 includes an event t-shirt! Wear it while you ride to promote Rotary.

Not a Rider? Any Participating club can sell \$10 General Admission Tickets for the event and keep 100% of the proceeds.
