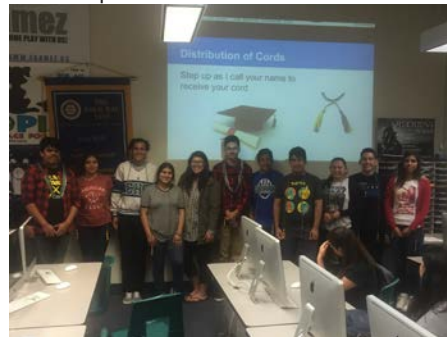
### Century H.S. Interact
