## Guest Speaker-Guide Dogs of America

Tina and Bandit (the guide dog) were our guests, courtesy of Lisa Scaglione. Tina trains the puppies for 18 months after which they go to GDofA for formal training and eventually matched with potential owners. As the trainers chart the dogs' behavior each day from birth and know them so well, they match them with the owners. The dogs train for 30 days with their owners and then spend the next 8 years working with them before they retire.

The dogs are free to the blind and it costs \$43,000 to train one dog. Funds are raised through the annual open house event and 'puppies for pennies'. Of the 300 dogs that are trained each year, only 50 graduate from the program. The remaining 250 are retrained for search and rescue, as therapy dogs and similar fields. Then there are the few dogs who just don't like to work at all.....!

The Labrador is considered the best breed for most owners; the golden retriever is best suited to more active owners and the Labrapoodle is best suited for owners with dog allergies..

# Rotary Chili Cook-Off Instructions Saturday, August 22nd, 2015

The following is information regarding participation in the Chili Cook-off at Angel Stadium.

## Arrival Time:

To secure your reserved spot near the "Big A" in the parking lot at Angel Stadium and to assure that all Clubs are ready to serve chili tasting to our fellow Rotarians and their guests, we ask that you arrive at 3:00PM.

**\* It is important that we have the names of those Members from your Club who will be arriving at 3:00PM to help set up your Club's area. Please send those names to Jon Cianci ([jrcianci@hotmail.com](mailto:jrcianci@hotmail.com)). Questions call Jon (310) 732-2359**

## Arrival Location:

Enter the Stadium parking lot at the **Orangewood Ave entrance**. The guard will have the names of those who have been listed by their Club (See Above Note). Proceed to the Big A parking lot area and you will see an area marked off with traffic cones. You will be directed to the area allotted to your Club.

## Club Set Up:

Clubs should bring Pop-ups, tables and chairs to meet their needs and protection from the sun. All heating elements used to keep their earlier cooked Chili warm should be fueled by **propane only**. Be prepared to serve chili to tasters by 3:30PM. You will need a ladle to serve. The District will be providing the bowls and spoons. We ask that all Clubs participating in the Chili contest **include a list of the ingredients at their serving table**.

## Close of Judging:

Clubs should discontinue serving at 4:50PM. The winners will be announced at 5:00PM. Best Chili will be selected by a panel of 2 executive Chefs and our Comedian Master of Ceremonies. The Grand Prize winner will receive their Club name displayed on the Big Screen during the game and engraved on the Coveted "Afterburn Cup" Trophy. Which the club will house, display and flaunt for the year.

## Reminder to your Club Members

This is a fundraiser for End Polio Now Campaign. Club members are urged to participate in the tasting and judging through purchase of a tasting bowl. Bowls/spoons/wristband will be sold for \$5/per person.

## Saturday, August 22nd, 2015



On Saturday, August 22nd, 2015 Rotarians are going to find out which Club in District 5320 makes the best darn chili.

The chili contest entry process is very simple. Just fill out the application; it can be found on our District web site at [Rotary5320.org](http://Rotary5320.org). The Club registration fee is \$50. If you have multiple chili aficionados in your club, you may enter additional chili recipes for the Cook-off for \$20 per each additional entry. There are no recipe rules/restrictions regarding what type or style of chili you wish to enter. Chili should be cooked off-site beforehand. **We only ask that on the day of the contest, display a list of the ingredients and whether your chili is mild, medium or hot.** Chili Cook-off registrants will have reserved spaces for their canopy, tables and chairs, and, of course, chili pot and stove. We would like the clubs participating in the Cook-off to set up at 3:00PM sharp. Tasting will start at 3:30PM when the general public is admitted to the parking lot.

Judging for the **BEST CHILI** will be done by a 3 person panel consisting of 2 Executive Chefs and our Master of Ceremonies. The Winner will receive recognition on the bug Screen during the game as well as the Club name engraved on the coveted "Afterburn Cup" perpetual trophy which the winner will proudly house and display for the year. Chili tasting wrist band, bowls and spoons will be sold for \$5 and are good for as much chili as you can taste; or is that take. The contest will end at 4:50PM. With the winner announced around 5:00pm

Registration revenue, all bowl sale proceeds and donations will go to the District's End Polio Now campaign. Each participating clubs will receive the proportionate net of ticket sales as a direct credit to their respective foundation Polio Plus goals.
