### Care for the Poor

Through the generosity of our donors, St. Joseph Hospital provides vital, often life-saving care to the working poor in our community. Without such support, many of these patients would have nowhere else to turn for care.

- La Amistad Family Health Center is devoted to providing high quality primary medical and dental healthcare services and education to the underserved in our community.
- Puente a La Salud Mobile Community Clinics serve all of Orange County. Puente provides access to primary medical, dental, vision care and health promotion services for workers and their families.

Funds raised through Care for the Poor will go directly to helping the underserved in our community, continuing St. Joseph Hospital's tradition of caring for the Dear Neighbor.



### Women's Services

At St. Joseph Hospital we think babies are pretty special and providing them with a welcoming, secure environment is a priority. This means construction of additional private patient rooms in our Mother Baby Unit where new parents can build bonds with their newest family member. And for babies needing a bit more attention during those early days, an onsite NICU staffed by CHOC specialists will be available.

The Center for Breast Imaging and Diagnosis at St. Joseph Hospital will focus on meeting the individual needs of each patient through an array of sophisticated imaging, diagnostic, treatment and support services. This center is designed to give busy women peace of mind and the confidence that no matter what the need – from prevention, early detection and diagnostic services through treatment and survivorship – they will receive the most advanced care available in the most convenient,

compassionate setting that is the signature of St. Joseph Hospital.

### The Center for Cancer Prevention and Treatment

Our three-story, standalone cancer center brings world-class care to Orange County in a single convenient location. In addition to offering advanced cancer prevention and treatment therapy, every aspect of the Center's design focuses on patient comfort and healing.

Philanthropy played a key role in the development of the Center. Over \$22 million in private donations supported the development of the 87,000 square foot cancer treatment facility, significantly surpassing the initial \$18 million goal.



### Patient Care Center

Coined "the hospital of the future" the Patient Care Center embodies the mission and vision of our Sisters. Featuring 14 operating suites and 150 acute and intensive care beds, the Patient Care Center offers some of the most advanced care in the county. Equally important is the Center's dedication to family and healing. Featuring a family waiting room, reflection rooms, and The Muth Healing Garden, the Center's design provides a comforting environment for loved ones and a healing environment for patients.

Community members, employees, corporations, physicians and foundations provided more than \$20 million in philanthropic support toward construction of the 250,000 square foot Patient Care Center.



### Hybrid Operating Room

St. Joseph Hospital is the first hospital in the nation to offer a true Hybrid Operating Room (OR) for the treatment of heart and vascular disorders in adult and pediatric patients. The OR features Artis Zeego, the first multi-axis imaging system that uses robotic technology and 3-D imaging software to reconstruct high-resolution images of the heart and vascular system. The advanced technology allows heart and vascular surgeons, interventional radiologists and interventional cardiologists to work together as highly efficient medical teams. This provides the maximum level of comfort and safety for patients and the opportunity to provide surgery options for high-risk patients.

As a part of the Heart and Vascular Center, the Hybrid OR was completed with generous support from the philanthropic community, ensuring healthy hearts for many years to come.

### St. Joseph & Hoag Hospital Affiliation

Chanda addressed a question about the agreement between St. Joseph Hospital and Hoag. A new legal entity was created called Covenant Health Network (CHN). Hoag and St. Joseph Health retained their individual identities and faith affiliations – Presbyterian and Catholic, respectively.

They are both non-profit, faith-based health care organizations, committed to providing the highest quality, affordable, and accessible health care services in the community. Both have also

achieved widespread recognition through thoughtful planning of their networks of services, fostering an environment of “best practice” health care, and reaching out to vulnerable populations with extensive community benefit programs.

Few key reasons: 1) Hoag benefits as they aren’t part of a large health system and the impact Obama Care is having on hospitals (declining reimbursements, back-off support to manage new administration requirements, etc.);

2) SJ has no presence in Newport Beach; 3) allows employees work in multiple locations and more access to personal care; and 4) can offer network of care in a system that is broken.

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### Background

Founded in 1929, St. Joseph Hospital is a values-based Catholic healthcare provider with a tradition of and commitment to excellence, based on the vision of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange (SJHS).

SJHS is an integrated Catholic health care delivery system providing a broad range of medical services. The system consists of 15 acute care hospitals, as well as home health agencies, hospice care, outpatient services, skilled nursing facilities, community clinics, and physician organizations. SJHS is organized into three regions -- Northern California, Southern California, and West Texas/Eastern New Mexico.

Fully accredited by The Joint Commission and designated as a Magnet hospital for nursing excellence, St. Joseph Hospital's reputation for clinical excellence and compassionate, family-centered care draws patients from all over the United States.

### **Community Benefit**

St. Joseph Hospital is committed to identifying and actively addressing unmet needs in the local communities we serve through charity care and by providing community services for the economically poor and the broader community. Community investment is hardwired into the hospital's organizational budget and financial planning. The hospital proactively commits

a percentage of its annual net income to fund community benefit efforts.

### **Physicians**

Many of our doctors are nationally known leaders in their clinical fields. Of our nearly 1,000-member Medical Staff, the vast majority of our doctors are board certified, and some are triple board certified. In addition, our doctors represent 74 medical specialties.

The majority of our doctors practice in either an independent office or as part of a medical group. Our doctors also participate in various insurance plans. Two physician networks associated with St. Joseph Heritage Healthcare are St. Joseph Hospital Affiliated Physicians and St. Joseph Heritage Medical Group.
